Silver Jewellery After Care Please Read Carefully

Your new silver jewellery is made from pure silver, also called .999 fine silver, this differs slightly from sterling silver. Sterling silver is 92.5% silver and 7.5% other metals (usually copper), the addition of the other metals hardens the silver slightly. Pure silver is slightly softer than sterling and is therefore subject to wear and tear but is more resistant to tarnishing.

To help to protect your jewellery from additional wear please try to avoid wearing it with other jewellery or where it can knock or scrape against other pieces (like charms). Always remove your jewellery before showering / bathing and before you go to bed. Never wear your jewellery in public swimming baths as the high chlorine content can damage the patina effect and badly tarnish the silver. Try to avoid spraying perfume / deodorants directly onto the piece as these again can affect the finish.

Never use a chemical dip or liquid polish to clean your jewellery, this can completely remove the patina effect on your piece. Only use a soft silver polishing cloth to gently remove any tarnish that may build up.

When not in use please place your jewellery back in the original box, this will help to protect it from tarnishing as there is a special anti tarnish pad inside.

Your new jewellery is a totally unique bespoke piece and as such deserves the extra care and attention.
